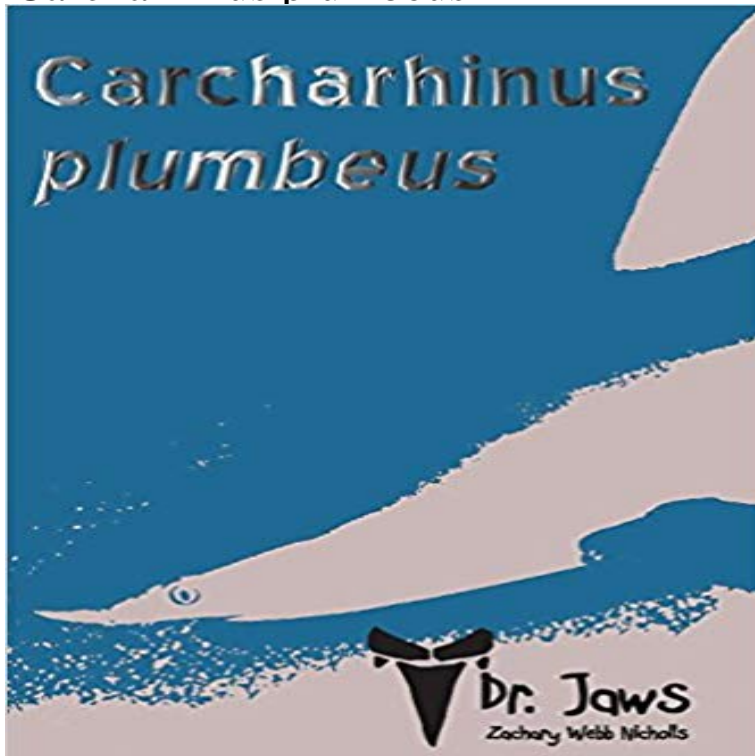


## Carcharhinus plumbeus
